(2 Corinthians 5:17)

Jesus died on the cross - even though he didn't deserve to die - and came back from the dead so that you could be forgiven of all your sins and experience a new beginning from God. You need that new beginning because you have broken God's laws and are separated from God. Think about it - ever had a bad experience anything? Have you used God's name as a curse word? Have you always obeyed your parents? These are just a few of the Ten Commandments. If you break one commandment, according to the Bible, you are guilty of breaking all of them. (See James 2:10)

Breaking God's law carries a penalty. "The wages of sin is death (in Hell) but the gift of God is eternal life (in Heaven) through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:23) Repent (turn away) from your sins today and Christ is your friend. Pray something like this: "God, I am sorry that I have sinned against you. I believe that Jesus died for my sin and rose from the dead. Forgive me and help me turn away from my sin. Thank you for saving me, Jesus."
